## Week I : Lesson The Meaning of Faith



# Let's Explore

Someone wise once said **"A man never stands taller than when he is on his knees."** George Washington was pretty tall at 6 feet 2 inches, but most would agree that he became even taller in moments like the one depicted above when he kneeled to pray for strength and help as the leader of the Continental Army during the Revolutionary War.

Faith is like a seed. We must care for our seed of faith with actions like reading the Word of God, serving others, praying, and listening to the messages that God speaks to our hearts if we want our faith to grow.

Scripture states, "If ye have faith as a grain of mustard seed, ye shall say unto this mountain, remove hence to yonder place; and it shall remove; and nothing shall be impossible unto you." (Matthew 17:20).

## Questions to Ask!



What happens when you plant a seed?



How do you make your faith grow like a plant?



**Plant seeds** outside as a family in your yard or inside in a pot as an object lesson to understand that faith is like a seed.

Measure and keep a log of the plant growth.

**Suggestions for Older Kids or Youth:** Use this quote or find your own, and use a method such as drawing, painting, woodwork, stitching, etc., to make a copy to place somewhere you will see it often (mirror, wall in your room, desk).

## Questions to Ask!



Why do you think the liberty bell is a symbol of faith and liberty?



Whose birthday did the bell ring for in 1846?



**Create a Symbol.** Use items around the house to make your own symbol of faith (God) and country. Be creative!



**Suggestions for Older Kids or Youth:** Internet Treasure Hunt: Search for 5 symbols that reflect the connection of love of for God and country. These could be either statues, places, or monuments.

Make an album and share the findings with your family. Consider visiting these symbols as a family if it is near your home.


