What to Expect

Ambassadors are part of the national Empower Moms team. They can be a member of a local **Moms for America**® Group or an Affiliate (*an individual not part of a Moms for America Group*) serving as point of contact for the school district they live in.

The Empower Moms team has created an entire program to equip our Ambassadors with everything needed to succeed. Training and certification include a 4-week webinar class hosted by Empower Moms Director Aly Legge that will prepare Ambassadors to interact with the local school board and officials. The classes will cover all the important information Ambassadors must know to effectively work with their local school district and administration.

- 1) The 4-week webinar training includes coverage of the following topics:
 - Your Why & SDA Responsibilities
 - Board Rules & Responsibilities
 - Federal & State Laws
 - Bylaws, Rules, & Policies
 - State Board of Education
 - How to Build Relationships with Board Employees
 - Contact Information & District Employees
 - Superintendent & Chief (cabinet) Positions
- 2) Ambassadors will attend school board meetings, workshops, and Moms for America group meetings (if available in the area). Ambassadors will:
 - Take notes for the Moms for America Group members (if a member of a Moms for America Group)
 - Develop an action plan to address issues that arise
 - Be prepared and equipped for legal actions if necessary

- 3) Ambassadors will mentor parents seeking involvement and will provide parents with resources (provided by Moms for America), including, but not limited to:
