# 5000 YEAR LEAP PRINCIPLE 3

“The best way to secure a virtuous and morally stable people is to elect virtuous leaders.”

Natural Aristocracy = Best citizens, called to serve, accept major roles in government.

Artificial Aristocracy - Obtain office, wealth through birth, station in life/special influences
