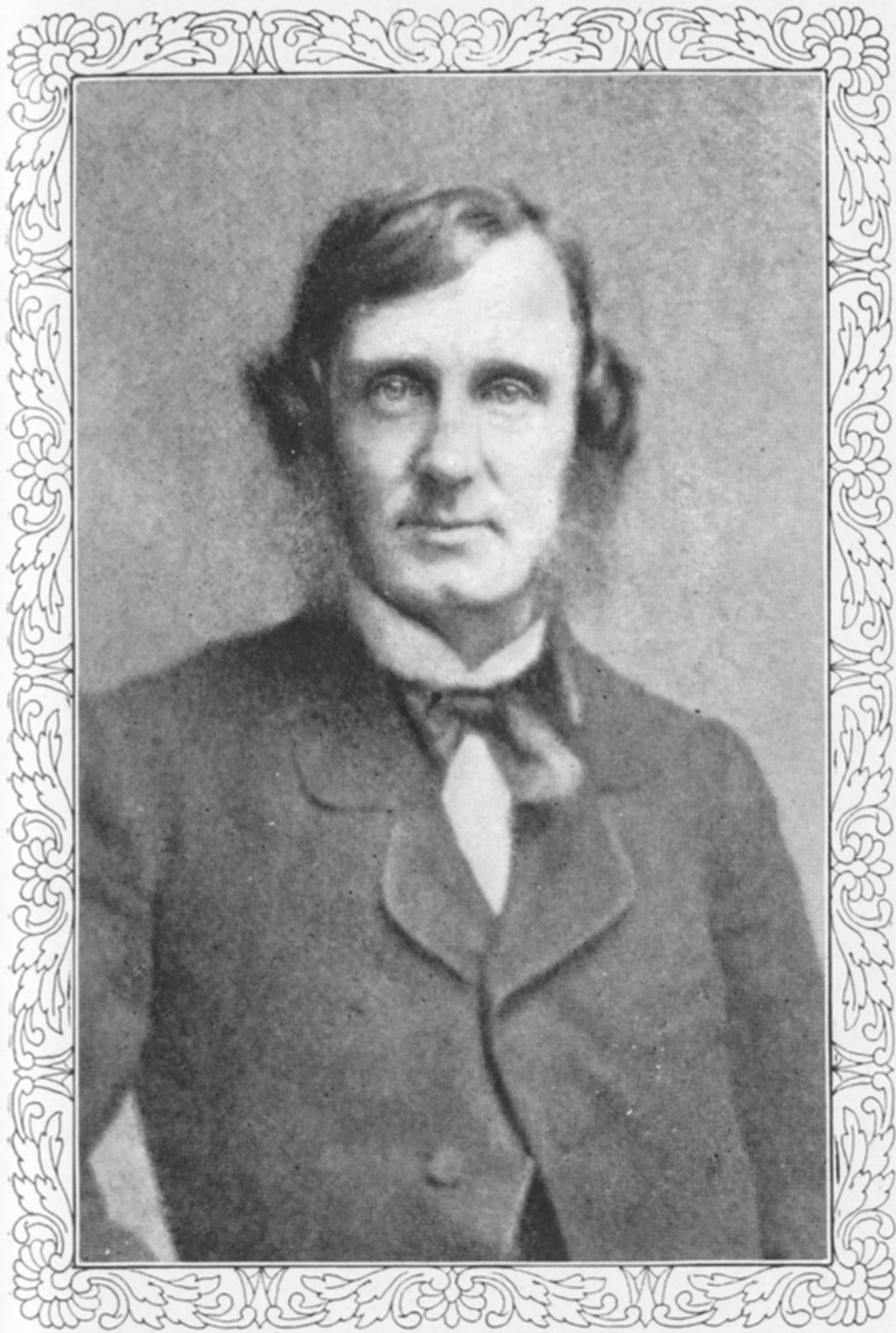


## ABIGAIL ADAMS: A MOTHER PATRIOT
