Our Core Beliefs

- We believe in God-given rights. We believe the rights proclaimed in the Declaration of Independence and the preamble to the US Constitution are incontrovertible. As such, we commit to defend the right to life, liberty and the pursuit of happiness (which includes private property) by preserving and protecting the Constitution of the United States and the Bill of Rights.
- 2. We value personal responsibility. This belief calls people up to self-governance, the value of work and the joy of self-determination and is supported in the US Constitution and natural law. As such, we endeavor to limit Government to its proper role.
 - 3. We believe love is strong. As such, we celebrate the intrinsic dignity of each member of the human race and honor that he or she is created purposefully in the image of God.
 - 4. We value freedom. We believe it is the foundation for a good society. As such, we actively study and apply freedom principles and promote the truth of our liberty loving heritage.


The national organization's role is to educate, support, and connect while giving our affiliate groups the autonomy to determine what issues are most important in their area.

National Organization: Responsible for executing the mission of Moms for America on the national level.

State Level

Local Level

Cottage Meetings: Through inspiring stories, personal experiences, and relatable examples, the 12 simple presentations of our cottage meetings introduce moms to the principles of liberty on which our nation was founded. As women meet together, they learn the story of America and the virtues and principles of liberty our nation was founded on.

MomLinks Groups: Groups of three or more women who regularly meeting in their community. Like-minded women together to foster community connections that nurture liberty, empower moms, and strengthen families.
